It has come to the notice of the undersigned that some students are requesting for assistance /fees deduction upon receipt of fees notice released by the Institute citing the bad impact of COVID-19 pandemic on the Society in general and most of the parents in particular.

The concern of our students are taken seriously in to consideration and addressed in the following manner for information.

- i. Although fees of 3rd/5th semester shall be collected on or before 31st August 2020 , the same is not mandatory for all .
- ii. Students those who fail to pay semester fees by 31st August 2020 and in installments , they can pay fees on a later date with permission of the undersigned, as no late fee or readmission fee shall be collected this year.
- iii. As regular classes are not conducted so far /hostel is not in operation and allotment of hostel seats will be decided after reopening of the Institute, students are already informed not pay hostel fees along with Institute fees. Appropriate deduction in hostel fees will be considered at the time of admission in the Institute hostel.
- iv. It is made clear to the students that, No increase/hike in the Institute fees is notified by the Institute as provided in the JEE Information brochure of the admitted year except student activity fee. It is decided not to collect student activity fee in the present semester. Those who have already paid the semester fee, the amount collected towards student activity fee , shall be adjusted in next semester fees.
- v. Institute fees fixed by the NCHMCT/Ministry of Tourism, Govt. of India is uniformly applicable to all Central Institutes in the Country. If any deduction in fees is considered by the appropriate authority in a later date, it shall be applicable to all the students of Central IHMs in the Country and exempted fees paid if any, shall be adjusted in future semester fees.
- vi. **As informed by NCHMCT & IGNOU (today), all students have to fill the online application for IGNOU re-registration and deposit Rs. 12,750/- towards IGNOU fee through online portal only. Institute will not collect IGNOU fee as per the instructions. However, those who have already paid their IGNOU fee along with Institute fee, the amount will be remitted back to the students very soon.**
